

### ***Minutes of the November 20, 2021, Meeting of the CV Alumni Assn.***

The meeting was called to order by President Rindy Brace. Also present were Nita Yager, Nancy Pearch, Robin Shetler, MaryAnna Cotter, Linda Shetler, Stacy Sanders, Becky Caufield, Susan Johnson, and Gerald Sanders.

Prayer was offered by MaryAnna.

Nita read the minutes of the previous meeting and after adding the name of MaryAnna as being present, Susan made a Motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Linda, all in favor, minutes approved.

The Treasurer's report was given by Nancy in Peg's absence. We received a \$40 donation giving us a new balance of \$7,701.26. It was asked if both teachers were paid their grant monies and it was reported they were; however, that will be verified.

Rindy asked what activities the group came up with since our last meeting and Susan suggested we get a cake for the firehouse in Bowerston when it is done. Robin reported that will not be until the spring. Rindy asked if there were any events coming up that we could attend. There were none known at this time. Gerald suggested a silent auction would be good. It was felt we should get one ready to go for the new gym and it was felt it could be a \$500 fundraiser. Stacy reported we will not be in the new gym this year. We would need to set an auction up in the foyer or cafeteria. It was suggested we do it during the Hall of Fame weekend. It was felt we need to make contact with Mr. Stuck, the Athletic Director at the school. Susan reported that there may be a copy paper shortage and we should keep that in mind. Stacy will reach out to Mr. Stuck. Nancy suggested we sell tickets at the game and award prizes at the dinner. It was also suggested we market the event as a silent auction at the Hall of Fame game. Rindy suggested a committee and everyone needs to get baskets. Nita suggested a class challenge for baskets and business involvement. Rindy will put the event on facebook for the classes. The baskets will be needed by January 7, 2022. Each basket should have the class year in it. Gerald felt we need a cover letter to make it official which should include the tax exempt form for businesses. Nancy suggested we include that they may make a donation in lieu of a basket. Rindy will work on the letter.

It was reported that the next Superintendent's meeting will be in January. Stacy will ask Rob about our event and get back to us.

Nancy updated the group on the student recognition event. The grant for the elementary education is not paid yet either and it would be \$285.60, leaving our new balance at \$7,415.66. Rindy reported she got the grant request for the CV ELA Team's family literacy night and she talked to Danielle about it. She asked if we could contribute something as it would help. Stacy expressed her disappointment that CV did not participate in the reading festival at the mall. Rindy felt we do not have funds for the full amount. Susan moved we donate \$250, Gerald seconded, all in favor. Susan reported on the Buckeye Book Fair where they have books for schools and suggested that the librarian go. It is a nice book fair. Rindy reported that the Scholastic Books has a book fair too. Linda said Ollie's is good for books too. Rindy reported that Danielle told her on Tuesday there will be parent/teacher conferences and there will be tables in the gym for organizations if we want a table. Gerald said he would go. Stacy will provide our brochures. Peggy has the ones we have left and Stacy will provide 25-30 more. Rindy will work the 10AM to 1:00PM shift. Linda can do 1-3:00PM, Gerald 3-5:00PM, Stacy and Tanner will do 5-8:00pm. We will skip 8-10PM. Nancy asked if we want T-shirts. Rindy will pick them up and cups too. It was suggested at the fire dept. opening in Bowerston we should sell Bowerston items. MaryAnna said Trangs book was handed out in New Phila.

Rindy reported Susan said Carol got nothing for the Board meeting and asked if we still want her to go. Gerald felt she should go and tell them our activities and can report back to us what they are doing.

MaryAnna had a list of deaths since July. Nancy will give it to Peg.

Nancy made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Susan, all in favor, meeting adjourned.
