

GENERAL FACILITY RULES

1. All members and visitors must check in at the front desk before entering any area of the facility.
2. All members must have their membership card and all visitors/guests must have their driver's license to enter the facility.
3. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
4. Age Limitations:
 - Patrons must be at least 15 years of age to use the fitness floors on their own. **Patrons 12-14 must have direct adult supervision to use the fitness and weight room.**
 - 11 and under are not permitted in the fitness and weight rooms.
5. No animals are permitted in the Rocket Center unless they are a certified service animal and may only be brought to the facility by its owner.
6. No food is permitted in the gymnasium, fitness areas, track, or natatorium. Only plastic and/or metal spill-proof drink containers are permitted.
7. The CVUL/Rocket Center is not responsible for lost, forgotten, or stolen items. Patrons are discouraged from bringing valuable items to the facility at any time. Personal belongings could be stored in lockers or cubbies. Please remember to take all personal items with you when you leave.
8. Lost and Found - Items will be kept at the front desk for one week. Unclaimed items will be donated to Goodwill. The RC staff will not hold or be responsible for any items during your visit. Please do not ask.
9. No skateboards, skates, hoverboards and/or heelys are permitted in or on the grounds of the Rocket Center.
10. The following activities are not permitted and may result in suspension, expulsion, exclusion, termination of membership/use of the facility and/or criminal punishment:
 - Fighting
 - Disorderly conduct
 - Harassment of any kind
 - Profanity / foul language or offensive clothing
 - Threatening / aggressive behavior
 - Excessive horseplay or running in the halls
 - Public displays of affection
 - Theft or damaging Rocket Center property
 - Littering (Be responsible for you and your group's trash items)
 - Using any kind of tobacco, spitting and/or vaping products
 - To use, possess, distribute or be under the influence of drugs or alcohol

- Defrauding a membership is prohibited
 - Disregarding the staff's enforcement of the rules
11. The RC staff will oversee and enforce the rules in every area in the facility. Individuals violating the policies of the Rocket Center will be addressed and may be written-up and asked to leave the facility. Students 18 and under will be able to contact their parents, if transportation is needed. The staff will follow-up with additional measures, if the act(s) committed warrants further action. The decision to suspend and length of suspension will be the sole discretion of the staff and RC Director or designee.
12. General Notices:
- a. The RC staff may change the facility use and/or schedule if deemed necessary. There will be times during the year that the Rocket Center or areas of the Rocket Center will be closed for scheduled or emergency maintenance. Refunds/Credits will not be available for these times.
 - b. No persons will be permitted to use the RC as a place of business unless they have been authorized by the CVULSD.
 - c. Members must acknowledge that participation in physical activities and programming at the Rocket Center may pose potential hazards and need to take all necessary measures of protection before starting.
13. All injuries, incidents and suspicious activity needs to be reported immediately to a staff member.
